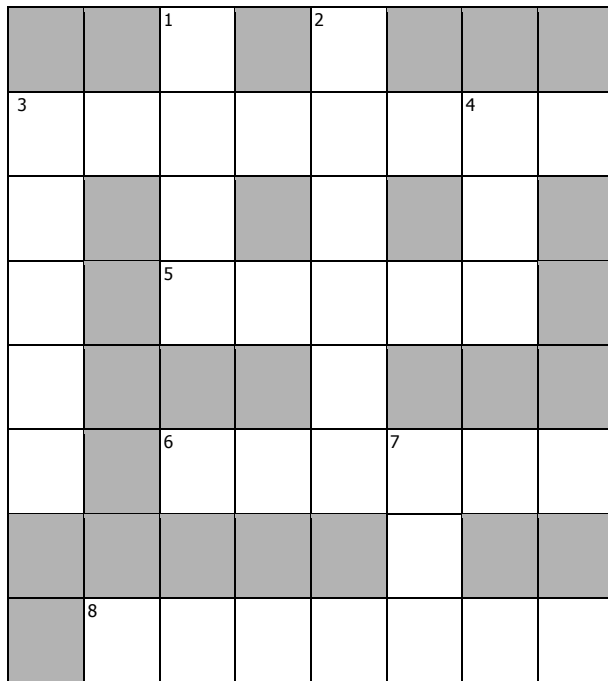

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







DESCRIPTIVE CLUES

3. Short and crisp.(8) 5. The set of five lines that music is written on.(5) 6. Could be a clef or a recorder.(6) 8. Symbol to cancel a sharp or a flat.(7)	1. Could be a clef or the lowest voice in a choir.(4) 2. An interval of eight notes.(6) 3. A symbol to raise pitch by a semitone.(5) 4. Adds the value of notes together.(3) 7. Measure.(3)
